LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

The regular session of the 2025 legislature began on January 13, 2025.

Good News: SB 5113, if enacted by the legislature, TRS 1 and PERS 1 retirees would get the same annual COLA that members of most other state-managed pension plans receive. This is a huge win for retirees, who have waited 13 years for their benefits to be restored.

Bad News: The state is experiencing a budget shortfall and legislators may not be willing to fund it.

Interesting News: There is possibility of merging the PERS, TRS and LEOFF (Law Enforcement) funds into one fund that has enough money to fund COLAs for all without affecting the State deficit. SB 5085 is the bill to support for this.

On the left side of the bill information is a box that says "Send a comment on this bill to your legislators." Press that box and you should be able to contact your representatives with support and make a comment. **The more support we get the better!**
